GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR THE DIRECTOR GENERAL ELECTED FOR THE 2002-2006 TERM

Pursuant to Article 20 of the Convention on IICA, the Director General elected for the 2002-2006 term will be the legal representative of the Institute, and has the responsibility of administering the General Directorate in order to carry out its functions and obligations.

Costa Rican legislation requires that power of attorney and general power of attorney be recorded with the Civil Registry of Costa Rica, host country for the Headquarters of the Institute.

In view of the above, the Inter-American Board of Agriculture (IABA), at its Eleventh Regular Meeting, must grant the Director General elected for the 2002-2006 period a General Power of Attorney.
